Bubber Miley first worked with Duke Ellington briefly in September 1923 when they were both sidemen with the Washingtonians led by banjoist Elmer Snowden. In November 1924 he was the star of the first two recordings by the new Duke Ellington Orchestra, “Choo Choo” and “Rainy Nights.” By that time, Miley had a distinctive sound and had developed into a master with the plunger mute.
