The name comes from the Greek γύρος (gyros, 'circle' or 'turn'), and is a calque of the Turkish word döner, from dönmek, also meaning "turn". It was originally called ντονέπ (pronounced [do'ner]) in Greece. The word ντονέπ was criticized in mid-1970s Greece for being Turkish.
